Mr. GOODLATTE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

A BILL

To require that a monthly statement of costs charged against the Official Mail Allowance for persons entitled to use the congressional frank be kept and made available to the public, and to reduce the amount of that allowance for any Member of the House of Representatives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 311 of the Legislative Appropriations Act,
5 1991 (2 U.S.C. 59e) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(3)—

1 (A) by inserting “(A)” before “shall in-
2 clude”; and

3 (B) by striking “frank.” and inserting
4 “frank, and (B) shall make available to the
5 public a monthly statement (based solely on
6 data provided for that purpose by such Com-
7 mittee) of costs charged against the Official
8 Mail Allowance for each person entitled to use
9 the congressional frank.”; and
10 (2) in subsection (e)(2)(B)(i) by striking “3”
11 and inserting “1.5”.

12 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

13 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
14 apply with respect to sessions of Congress beginning after
15 the date of the enactment of this Act.
