Mr. WOLF introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the orderly termination of easements and property used for public utility purposes at the Manassas National Battlefield Park.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Manassas National
5 Battlefield Park Amendments of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. ORDERLY TERMINATION.**

7 Subsection (b)(2)(C) of the first section of the Act
8 entitled “An Act to preserve within Manassas National
9 Battlefield Park, Virginia the most important historic
10 properties relating to the battle of Manassas, and for other

1 purposes”, approved April 17, 1954 (16 U.S.C. 429b), is
2 amended by adding at the end the following: “The owner
3 of any easement or property used for public utility pur-
4 poses which are taken pursuant to this paragraph may ini-
5 tiate a proceeding in a court of competent jurisdiction
6 seeking a determination of just compensation with respect
7 to the taking of such property at any time within nine
8 years after the date of enactment of the Manassas Na-
9 tional Battlefield Park Amendments of 1988.”.

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
