A BILL

For the relief of Ayo Martins.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE STATUS FOR AYO**
4 **MARTINS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), for pur-
6 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Ayo Mar-
7 tins shall be considered to have been lawfully admitted to
8 the United States for permanent residence as of the date
9 of the enactment of this Act, upon payment of the required
10 visa fees.

11 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION.—Subsection (a)
12 shall apply only if Ayo Martins applies to the Attorney

- 1 General for permanent residence status pursuant to such
- 2 subsection within 2 years after the date of the enactment
- 3 of this Act.
