Mr. TAYLOR of North Carolina introduced the following bill; which was referred jointly to the Committees on House Administration and Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To change election day for Federal offices to the first Monday in November and to make election day a legal public holiday.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON THE**
4 **FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER OF EACH**
5 **EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR.**

6 Section 25 of the Revised Statutes of the United
7 States (2 U.S.C. 7) and section 1 of title 3, United States
8 Code, are each amended by striking out “Tuesday next
9 after the”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELECTION DAY TO BE A LEGAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY.**

2 Section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
3 amended by inserting after the item relating to Columbus
4 Day the following new item:

5 “Election Day, the first Monday in November of each
6 even-numbered year.”
