



1 **“§ 41706. Prohibitions against smoking on scheduled**  
2 **flights**

3 “(a) SMOKING PROHIBITION IN INTRASTATE AND  
4 INTERSTATE AIR TRANSPORTATION.—An individual may  
5 not smoke in an aircraft on a scheduled airline flight seg-  
6 ment in interstate air transportation or intrastate air  
7 transportation.

8 “(b) SMOKING PROHIBITION IN FOREIGN AIR  
9 TRANSPORTATION.—The Secretary of Transportation  
10 shall require all air carriers and foreign air carriers to pro-  
11 hibit, on and after the 120th day following the date of  
12 the enactment of the Airliner Cabin Air Quality Act of  
13 1994, smoking in any aircraft on a scheduled airline flight  
14 segment within the United States or between a place in  
15 the United States and a place outside the United States.

16 “(c) LIMITATION ON APPLICABILITY.—The smoking  
17 prohibitions contained in subsections (a) and (b) shall  
18 apply only to the passenger cabin and lavatory of an air-  
19 craft operated by a foreign air carrier.

20 “(d) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary shall prescribe  
21 regulations necessary to carry out this section.”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall take effect on the 60th day following  
3 the date of the enactment of this Act.

# **H. R. 4495**

## **AN ACT**

To amend the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 to prohibit smoking on all scheduled airline flight segments in air transportation or intrastate air transportation.
