## A BILL

To amend chapter 11 of title 31, United States Code, to require that the President's budget submission separately reflect the budget aggregates relating to activities within the unified budget and aggregates relating to activities required by law to be excluded from the unified budget.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET.**

4       Section 1105 of chapter 11 of title 31, United States  
5       Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new  
6       subsection:

1       “(g) The budget transmitted pursuant to subsection  
2 (a) for a fiscal year shall set forth all budget aggregates  
3 (including receipts, disbursements, and deficits) only as  
4 follows: One set of aggregates shall relate solely to activi-  
5 ties of the Federal budget which are within the unified  
6 budget and one set of aggregates shall relate solely to ac-  
7 tivities of the Federal budget which are off-budget.”.

8 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

9       The amendment made by section 1 shall become ef-  
10 fective for fiscal year 1996 and shall be fully reflected in  
11 the fiscal year 1996 budget submitted by the President  
12 in February 1995 as required by section 1105(a) of title  
13 31, United States Code.
