Mr. ANDREWS of Maine introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries

A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, to prohibit overhaul, repair, and maintenance of Coast Guard vessels in foreign shipyards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Shipbuilding
5 Jobs Preservation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON OVERHAUL, REPAIR, AND MAIN-**
2 **TENANCE OF COAST GUARD VESSELS IN FOR-**
3 **EIGN SHIPYARDS.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—Chapter 5 of title 14, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
6 ing:

7 **“§96. Prohibition on overhaul, repair, and mainte-**
8 **nance of Coast Guard vessels in foreign**
9 **shipyards**

10 “A Coast Guard vessel may not be overhauled, re-
11 paired, or maintained in any shipyard located outside the
12 United States, except that this section does not apply to
13 emergency repairs.”.

14 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—Title 14, United
15 States Code, is amended in the analysis at the beginning
16 of chapter 5 by adding at the end the following:

“96. Prohibition on overhaul, repair, and maintenance of Coast Guard vessels
in foreign shipyards.”.
