## A BILL

To provide for the reliquidation of certain entries of imported chemicals.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of  
5       the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-  
6       vision of law, upon proper request filed with the United  
7       States Customs Service within 180 days after the date of  
8       the enactment of this Act, the Customs Service shall—

9               (1) reliquidate the entries described in sub-  
10       section (b) at the rate of duty of 3.7 percent ad va-  
11       lorem; and

1           (2) refund to the importer the appropriate  
2           amount of import duty paid with respect to such en-  
3           tries.

4           (b) AFFECTED ENTRIES.—The entries referred to in  
5           subsection (a) are as follows:
