3       **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL COUNTIES IN**  
4                       **STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AS PART OF APPA-**  
5                       **LACHIAN REGION.**

6       The 5th undesignated paragraph of section 403 of  
7 the Appalachian Regional Development Act of 1965 (40  
8 U.S.C. App. 403) is amended—

9               (1) by inserting “Carroll” after “Calhoun”;

1 (2) by inserting “Grenada” after “Clay”; and

2 (3) by inserting “Montgomery” after “Monroe”.
