Mr. DICKEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of the estate of Wallace B. Sawyer, Jr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any
5 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the
6 estate of Wallace B. Sawyer, Jr., the sum of \$608,715.40.
7 The payment required by this section shall be in full satis-
8 faction of all claims that the estate or family of Wallace
9 B. Sawyer, Jr., may have against the United States aris-
10 ing from the death of Wallace B. Sawyer, Jr., following
11 an October 5, 1986, missile attack on the airplane in

1 which he was a crewmember performing services for and
2 at the direction of the United States.

3 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENT AND ATTORNEY FEES.**

4 It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-
5 cent of the payment required by section 1 to be paid to
6 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-
7 dered in connection with the payment. Any person or es-
8 tate violating this section shall be guilty of an infraction,
9 and shall be subject to a fine in the amount provided in
10 title 18, United States Code.
