1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELWHA RIVER ECOSYSTEM AND FISHERIES**  
4 **RESTORATION EXPENDITURES.**

5 Section 9 of the Elwha River Ecosystem and Fish-  
6 eries Restoration Act (Public Law 102-495; 106 Stat.  
7 3178) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “for expenditure through the  
2           Assistant Secretary for Fish, Wildlife, and Parks”;  
3           and

4           (2) by striking “for expenditure through the  
5           National Marine Fisheries Service”.
