Mr. BARTON of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works and Transportation

A BILL

To prohibit aircraft from flying over The Ballpark in Arlington, in Arlington, Texas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION.**

4 Except in the case of an in-flight emergency, flights
5 for purposes of providing law enforcement or medical as-
6 sistance, and for flights of aircraft, carrying members of
7 the media, which flights are authorized by the mayor of
8 Arlington, Texas or the authorized agent of the mayor,
9 aircraft are prohibited from flying at less than 2,000 feet
10 above mean sea level over, and within 2,000 feet horizontal

1 distance of, The Ballpark in Arlington, located in Arling-
2 ton, Texas. The Administrator of the Federal Aviation Ad-
3 ministration shall provide for the depiction and publication
4 of such prohibition on appropriate charts in order to pro-
5 vide notice to airmen of such prohibition.

6 **SEC. 2. VIOLATIONS.**

7 A violation of the provisions of this Act shall be treat-
8 ed as a violation of chapter 441 of title 49, United States
9 Code, is treated for purposes of civil penalty and certifi-
10 cate enforcement action by the Administrator of the Fed-
11 eral Aviation Administration.

12 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

13 The provisions of this Act shall take effect 120 days
14 after the date of its enactment.
