Mr. WILLIAMS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To limit the authority of the Interstate Commerce Commission to overturn certain employee protection agreements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION OF AUTHORITY.**

4 (a) AMENDMENTS.—(1) Section 10327(g)(1) of title
5 49, United States Code, is amended by inserting “The
6 Commission may not use the authority granted under this
7 paragraph to overturn an employee protection arrange-
8 ment agreed to by all parties to the arrangement.” after
9 “regulations of the Commission.”.

1 (2) Section 11351 of title 49, United States Code,
2 is amended by inserting “The Commission may not use
3 the authority granted under this section to overturn an
4 employee protection arrangement agreed to by all parties
5 to the arrangement.” after “11347 of this title.”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 subsection (a) shall be effective as of January 1, 1984.
