Mr. HUNTER (for himself and Ms. DUNN) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To direct the Attorney General of the United States to enforce existing anti-pornography laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Anti-Pornography
5 Strikeforce Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DIRECTION TO ATTORNEY GENERAL.**

7 The Attorney General shall—

8 (1) direct the Child Exploitation and Obscenity
9 Section of the Criminal Division of the Department
10 of Justice to prosecute all violations of sections

1 1462, 1463, 1464, 1465, 1467, 2251, 2252, and
2 2253 of title 18, United States Code, and section
3 223 of the Communications Act of 1934, to the full-
4 est extent possible, focusing on the proliferation of
5 child pornography and the electronic transmission of
6 obscene materials;

7 (2) expand the number of prosecutors in the
8 Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section to 15 full-
9 time positions, and include necessary support per-
10 sonnel; and

11 (3) allocate the necessary resources and man-
12 power within the Federal Bureau of Investigation to
13 assist in the investigation of violations described in
14 paragraph (1).
