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## A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 2-YEAR EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR ISSUANCE**

4 **OF MEDICARE SELECT POLICIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4358(c) of the Omnibus  
6 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 1320c-3

1 note) is amended by striking “3-year” and inserting “5-  
2 year”.

3 (b) DEADLINE FOR EVALUATION.—Section 4358(d)  
4 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1320c-3 note) is amended by strik-  
5 ing “January 1, 1995” and inserting “January 1, 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect  
8 as if included in the enactment of the Omnibus Budget  
9 Reconciliation Act of 1990.

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
