Mr. McCLOSKEY (for himself and Mrs. MORELLA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To authorize noncompetitive, career or career-conditional appointments for temporary and term employees of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, including those assigned to the Resolution Trust Corporation, who are separated due to downsizing and office closures or due to the termination of the Resolution Trust Corporation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Temporary Employee
5 Placement Assistance Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NONCOMPETITIVE CAREER OR CAREER-CONDI-**
2 **TIONAL APPOINTMENTS FOR SEPARATED**
3 **TEMPORARY OR TERM EMPLOYEES OF THE**
4 **FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORA-**
5 **TION, INCLUDING THOSE ASSIGNED TO THE**
6 **RESOLUTION TRUST CORPORATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—An individual described in sub-
8 section (b) may be appointed noncompetitively, under a
9 career or career-conditional appointment, to a position in
10 the competitive service if—

11 (1) the individual meets the qualification re-
12 quirements prescribed by the Office of Personnel
13 Management for the position to which appointed;

14 (2) the last previous Federal employment of the
15 individual was as a temporary or term employee who
16 was employed for at least two years by the Federal
17 Deposit Insurance Corporation, including a tem-
18 porary or term employee of the Federal Deposit In-
19 surance Corporation assigned to the Resolution
20 Trust Company; and

21 (3) the appointment is effected within three
22 years following the date of separation from the last
23 position described in paragraph (2).

24 (b) INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED.—An individual de-
25 scribed in this subsection is an individual who—

26 (1) on the date of the enactment of this Act—

1 (A) is or was an employee of the Federal
2 Deposit Insurance Corporation, including an
3 employee assigned to the Resolution Trust Cor-
4 poration; and

5 (B) is serving or served in an appointed
6 position described in subsection (a)(2) whose
7 employment has been or will be terminated by
8 involuntary separation, resignation in lieu of in-
9 voluntary action, or expiration of appointment
10 due to Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation
11 downsizing or office closure, or Resolution
12 Trust Corporation downsizing or office closure,
13 or the termination of the Resolution Trust Cor-
14 poration; and

15 (2) is not separated from the position referred
16 to in paragraph (1)(B) for cause.

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
