3 **SECTION 1. BLOCK GRANTS REGARDING MENTAL HEALTH**

4 **AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE; TRANSFERS BE-**

5 **TWEEN ALLOTMENTS.**

6 Section 205(b) of Public Law 102-321 (106 Stat.

7 415) is amended in each of paragraphs (1) and (2) by

1 striking “1993 or 1994” and inserting “1993, 1994, or
2 1995”.

3 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM ALLOTMENTS.**

4 Part B of title XIX of the Public Health Service Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 300x-1 et seq.) is amended in each of sections
6 1918(b) and 1933(b) by striking “1993 and 1994” and
7 inserting “1993, 1994, and 1995”.
