A BILL

To repeal the ban on semiautomatic assault weapons and the ban on large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF THE BAN ON SEMIAUTOMATIC AS-**
4 **SAULT WEAPONS AND THE BAN ON LARGE**
5 **CAPACITY AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United
7 States Code, is amended by striking subsections (v) and
8 (w) and by striking the appendix.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS AND REPEAL.—

2 (1) Section 921(a) of such title is amended by
3 striking paragraph (31).

4 (2) Section 924(a)(1)(B) of such title is amend-
5 ed by striking “(r), (v),”.

6 (3) Section 923(i) of such title is amended by
7 striking the last 2 sentences.

8 (4) Section 110104 of the Violent Crime Con-
9 trol and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 is hereby re-
10 pealed.
