A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to provide for an Executive Director of the General Accounting Office Personnel Appeals Board, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.**

4 (a) POSITION.—Section 752 of title 31, United States
5 Code, is amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-
6 ing new subsection:

7 “(c)(1) The Comptroller General shall appoint the
8 Executive Director of the Board.

1 **SEC. 3. PARTICIPATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE**
2 **HEALTH CARE PROGRAM.**

3 Section 732 of title 31, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
5 subsection:

6 “(h) The Comptroller General may enter into inter-
7 agency agreements with the Department of State and
8 other executive agencies to permit the General Accounting
9 Office to participate in programs for the provision of
10 health care to government employees stationed abroad or
11 performing temporary duty abroad.”.
