A BILL

To provide for expediting an investigation by the International Trade Commission by providing for the monitoring of the importation of certain kinds of tomatoes and peppers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “North American Free
5 Trade Agreement Implementation Act Amendments of
6 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION MONITORING**
2 **OF CERTAIN VEGETABLES INTENDED FOR**
3 **FRESH MARKET USE.**

4 Section 316 of the North American Free Trade
5 Agreement Implementation Act (19 U.S.C. 3381), is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 **“SEC. 316. MONITORING.**

8 “For purposes of expediting an investigation concern-
9 ing provisional relief under this title or section 202 of the
10 Trade Act of 1974 regarding—

11 “(1) fresh or chilled tomatoes suitable for fresh-mar-
12 ket use provided for in heading 0702.00 of the HTS; and

13 “(2) fresh or chilled peppers, other than chili peppers,
14 suitable for fresh-market use provided for in subheading
15 0709.60.00 of the HTS;

16 the International Trade Commission, until January 1,
17 2009, shall monitor imports of such goods as if proper
18 requests for such monitoring had been made under sub-
19 section (d)(1)(C)(i) of section 202. At the request of the
20 International Trade Commission, the Secretary of Agri-
21 culture and the Commissioner of Customs shall provide
22 to the International Trade Commission information rel-
23 evant to the monitoring carried out under this section.”
