1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE EMIS-**

4 **SION STANDARDS.**

5 Section 202 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7401
6 and following) is amended as follows:

7 (1) Subsection (a)(1) is amended by adding at
8 the end thereof the following: "For all motor vehicles
9 in any class or category manufactured after the
10 model year 1995, the standard promulgated by the

1 Administrator under this section shall be the stand-
2 ard applicable to such class or category of motor ve-
3 hicle in the model year 1995.”.

4 (2) Subsection (a)(3)(B)(ii) is repealed.

5 (3) Subsection (h) is repealed.

6 (4) Subsection (i) is repealed.
