1 **SECTION 1. APPLICATION BY WINDOW ROCK, ARIZONA,**
2 **LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY FOR FUNDING**
3 **UNDER SECTION 3 OF PUBLIC LAW 874, 81ST**
4 **CONGRESS.**

5 Notwithstanding section 5(a)(2) of the Act of Sep-
6 tember 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, 81st Congress; 20
7 U.S.C. 240(a)(2)) (as such section was in effect on the
8 day before the date of the enactment of the Improving
9 America's Schools Act of 1994), the Secretary of Edu-
10 cation shall accept from the local educational agency serv-
11 ing the Window Rock Unified School District, Window
12 Rock, Arizona, applications for funding under section 3
13 of the Act of September 30, 1950 (as so in effect) for
14 fiscal years 1994 and 1995 as if such applications were
15 timely received in accordance with section 222.10(a)(1) of
16 title 34, Code of Federal Regulations.
