## A BILL

For the relief of Jose J. Aceves.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF CLAIM.**

4       The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of any  
5       money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Jose  
6       J. Aceves of the District of Columbia, the sum of  
7       \$2,000,000. The payment shall be in full satisfaction of  
8       all claims Jose J. Aceves may have against the United  
9       States arising out of unfounded and unsupported  
10       targeting, harassment, allegations, and criminal actions by  
11       the Federal Bureau of Investigation since July 1987.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

2       It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10  
3 percent of the sum described in section 1 to be paid to  
4 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-  
5 dered in connection with the benefits provided by this Act.  
6 Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an  
7 infraction and shall be subject to a fine in the amount  
8 provided in title 18, United States Code.
