Mr. TORRICELLI introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To close loopholes in the firearms laws which allow the unregulated manufacture, assembly, shipment, or transportation of firearms or firearm parts, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST SHIPMENT OR TRANS-**
4 **PORTATION OF FIREARM PARTS, WITH CER-**
5 **TAIN EXCEPTIONS.**

6 Section 921(a)(3)(B) of title 18, United States Code,
7 is amended by inserting “(and, for purposes of section

1 922(a)(2), the barrel, stock, ammunition magazine, or any
2 part of the action)” before “of any such weapon”.

3 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST MANUFACTURE OR ASSEM-**
4 **BLY OF FIREARMS BY PERSONS OTHER THAN**
5 **LICENSED MANUFACTURERS.**

6 Section 922 of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

8 “(y) It shall be unlawful for any person other than
9 a licensed manufacturer to manufacture or assemble a
10 firearm.”.

11 **SEC. 3. INCREASE IN FEE FOR LICENSE TO MANUFACTURE**
12 **FIREARMS.**

13 Section 923(a)(1)(B) of title 18, United States Code,
14 is amended by striking “\$50” and inserting “\$500”.

15 **SEC. 4. PROHIBITION AGAINST POSSESSION OR TRANSFER**
16 **OF CERTAIN COMBINATIONS OF MACHINE-**
17 **GUN REPLACEMENT PARTS.**

18 Section 5845(b) of the National Firearms Act is
19 amended in the 2nd sentence by striking “designed and
20 intended solely and exclusively, or combination of parts de-
21 signed and intended,” and inserting “or combination of
22 parts designed and intended”.

1 **SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to con-
3 duct engaged in after the 60-day period that begins with
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
