A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize certain programs relating to traumatic brain injury and to trauma research.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Traumatic Brain Injury*
3 *Reauthorization Act of 2013”.*

4 **SEC. 2. CDC PROGRAMS FOR PREVENTION AND SURVEIL-**
5 **LANCE OF TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY.**

6 (a) *PREVENTION.*—Section 393B(b)(3) of the Public
7 *Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b–1c(b)(3)) is amended*
8 *by striking “health-status goals for 2010, commonly referred*
9 *to as Healthy People 2010” and inserting “health-status*
10 *goals for 2020, commonly referred to as Healthy People*
11 *2020”.*

12 (b) *SURVEILLANCE.*—Subsection (b) of section 393C of
13 *the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b–1d) is*
14 *amended—*

15 (1) *by striking “(b) Not later than” and insert-*
16 *ing the following:*

17 “(b) *REPORTS.*—

18 (1) *INITIAL REPORT.*—Not later than”; and

19 (2) *by adding at the end the following:*

20 (2) *SUBSEQUENT REPORT.*—Not later than 24
21 *months after the date of enactment of the Traumatic*
22 *Brain Injury Reauthorization Act of 2013, the Sec-*
23 *retary, acting through the Director of the Centers for*
24 *Disease Control and Prevention and the Director of*
25 *the National Institutes of Health and in consultation*
26 *with the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of*

1 *Veterans Affairs, shall submit to the relevant commit-*
2 *tees of Congress a report that—*

3 *“(A) identifies which recommendations in*
4 *the report under paragraph (1) have been adopt-*
5 *ed and which recommendations in such report*
6 *have not been adopted; and*

7 *“(B) includes a description of planned ac-*
8 *tivities to address each recommendation in such*
9 *report that has not been adopted.”.*

10 *(c) FUNDING.—Section 394A of the Public Health*
11 *Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280b–3) is amended—*

12 *(1) by striking “and” after “1994,”;*

13 *(2) by striking the second period at the end; and*

14 *(3) by adding at the end the following: “Of the*
15 *amounts made available to carry out this part for*
16 *each of fiscal years 2014 through 2018, there is au-*
17 *thorized to be appropriated \$6,100,000 to carry out*
18 *sections 393B and 393C.”.*

19 **SEC. 3. STATE GRANTS FOR PROJECTS REGARDING TRAU-**
20 **MATIC BRAIN INJURY.**

21 *Section 1252 of the Public Health Service Act (42*
22 *U.S.C. 300d–52) is amended—*

23 *(1) in subsection (a), by striking “, acting*
24 *through the Administrator of the Health Resources*
25 *and Services Administration,”;*

1 (2) *in paragraphs (1)(A)(i) and (3)(E) of sub-*
 2 *section (f), by striking “brain injury” and inserting*
 3 *“traumatic brain injury”;*

4 (3) *in subsection (h), by striking the comma*
 5 *after “under this section” and inserting a comma be-*
 6 *fore “including”; and*

7 (4) *by amending subsection (j) to read as follows:*

8 “(j) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For car-*
 9 *rying out this section and section 1253, there is authorized*
 10 *to be appropriated \$9,760,000 for each of fiscal years 2014*
 11 *through 2018.”.*

12 **SEC. 4. STATE GRANTS FOR PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY**
 13 **SERVICES.**

14 *Section 1253 of the Public Health Service Act (42*
 15 *U.S.C. 300d–53) is amended—*

16 (1) *in subsection (a), by striking “, acting*
 17 *through the Administrator of the Health Resources*
 18 *and Services Administration (referred to in this sec-*
 19 *tion as the ‘Administrator’),”;*

20 (2) *in subsections (c), (d)(1), (e)(1), (e)(4), (g),*
 21 *(h), and (j)(1), by striking “Administrator” each*
 22 *place it appears and inserting “Secretary”;*

23 (3) *in subsection (h)—*

24 (A) *by striking the subsection heading and*
 25 *inserting “REPORTING”;*

1 (B) by striking “Each protection and advo-
2 cacy system” and inserting the following:

3 “(1) *REPORTS BY SYSTEMS.*—Each protection
4 and advocacy system”; and

5 (C) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(2) *REPORT BY SECRETARY.*—Not later than 1
7 year after the date of enactment of the *Traumatic*
8 *Brain Injury Reauthorization Act of 2013*, the Sec-
9 retary shall prepare and submit to the appropriate
10 committees of Congress a report describing the serv-
11 ices and activities carried out under this section dur-
12 ing the period for which the report is being pre-
13 pared.”.

14 (4) in subsection (i)—

15 (A) by striking “Administrator of the
16 Health Resources and Services Administration”
17 and inserting “Secretary”; and

18 (B) by striking “by the Administrator” and
19 inserting “by the Secretary”;

20 (5) in subsection (k), by striking “subtitle C”
21 and inserting “subtitle C of title I”;

22 (6) by striking subsection (l) (relating to author-
23 ization of appropriations); and

24 (7) by redesignating subsection (m) as subsection
25 (l).

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
