Mr. CAMP introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

## A BILL

To provide assistance to certain agricultural producers whose crop quality has been adversely effected by drought, heat, wind, excessive moisture, or other natural climatological event; and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That section 2245 of the Food, Agriculture, Conservation,  
4       and Trade Act of 1990 Public Law 101-624; 7 U.S.C.  
5       note) is amended by striking the word “may” in sub-  
6       section (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the word “shall”,  
7       and by striking all of subsection (b) of section 2245 and  
8       inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1       “(b) Producers on a farm of a crop described in sub-  
2 section (a) shall be eligible to receive reduced quality dis-  
3 aster payments only if such producers incur due to re-  
4 duced crop quality a deficiency in the value of their pro-  
5 duction of not less than 35 percent for such crop (as deter-  
6 mined generally under section 2241, 2242, 2243, or 2244,  
7 as appropriate).”.
