**A BILL**

To authorize the adjustment of the boundaries of the South Dakota portion of the Sioux Ranger District of Custer National Forest, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SIOUX RANGER DISTRICT BOUNDARY ADJUST-**  
2 **MENT.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—In accordance with the Act enti-  
4 tled “An Act to consolidate national forest lands”, ap-  
5 proved March 20, 1922 (16 U.S.C. 485 et seq.), and in  
6 exchange for national forest lands in Custer National For-  
7 est, the Secretary of Agriculture may accept title to any  
8 lands located within five miles of the exterior boundaries  
9 of the South Dakota portion of the Sioux Ranger District  
10 of Custer National Forest that are not owned by the  
11 United States and that are found by the Secretary of Agri-  
12 culture to be chiefly valuable for national forest purposes.

13 (b) INCORPORATION INTO CUSTER NATIONAL FOR-  
14 EST.—Upon acceptance of title by the Secretary of Agri-  
15 culture, lands conveyed to the United States in accordance  
16 with subsection (a) shall become part of the Custer  
17 National Forest.
