H. R. 734

AMENDMENT

In the Senate of the United States,

August 19 (legislative day, August 18), 1994.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 734) entitled “An Act to amend the Act entitled ‘An Act to provide for the extension of certain Federal benefits, services, and assistance to the Pascua Yaqui Indians of Arizona, and for other purposes’”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Page 3, after line 2, insert:

1 ***SEC. 2. STUDY.***

2 *The Act entitled “An Act to provide for the extension*
3 *of certain Federal benefits, services, and assistance to the*
4 *Pascua Yaqui Indians of Arizona, and for other purposes”*
5 *(25 U.S.C. 1300f et seq.) is amended by adding at the end*
6 *the following new section:*

7 ***“SEC. 4. STUDY.***

8 *“(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior shall*
9 *conduct one or more studies to determine—*

1 “(1) whether the lands held in trust on the date
2 of enactment of this section by the United States for
3 the Pascua Yaqui Tribe are adequate for the needs of
4 the tribe for the foreseeable future;

5 “(2) if such lands are not adequate—

6 “(A) whether suitable additional lands are
7 available for acquisition by exchange or pur-
8 chase; and

9 “(B) the cost and location of the suitable
10 additional lands;

11 “(3) whether the Pascua Yaqui Tribe has suffi-
12 cient water rights and allocations to meet the needs
13 of the tribe for the foreseeable future;

14 “(4) if such water rights and allocations are not
15 adequate—

16 “(A) whether additional water can be ac-
17 quired; and

18 “(B) the potential sources and associated
19 costs of such additional water;

20 “(5) whether the Bureau of Indian Affairs and
21 the Indian Health Service have limited funding to the
22 Pascua Yaqui Tribe based on a determination of the
23 tribal enrollment in 1978, rather than the current en-
24 rollment;

1 “(6) if funding has been based on 1978 enroll-
2 ment, how the funding levels can be adjusted to ensure
3 that the Pascua Yaqui Tribe receives a fair and equi-
4 table portion of Bureau of Indian Affairs and Indian
5 Health Service funding;

6 “(7) the genealogy of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe;
7 and

8 “(8) the economic development opportunities
9 available to the tribe as a result of the North Amer-
10 ican Free Trade Agreement.

11 “(b) TRIBAL PARTICIPATION.—The Secretary shall
12 provide for the participation of members of the Pascua
13 Yaqui tribe to carry out subsection (a).

14 “(c) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date
15 on which funds are made available to carry out this section,
16 the Secretary of the Interior shall submit a report to Con-
17 gress that contains the results of each study conducted pur-
18 suant to subsection (a).

19 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
20 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-
21 essary to carry out this section.”.
