A BILL

To extend the Export Administration Act of 1979 and to authorize appropriations under that Act for fiscal years 1993 and 1994.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Section 18 of the Export Administration Act of 1979
5 (50 U.S.C. App. 2417) is amended by striking subsection
6 (b) and inserting the following:

7 “(b) AUTHORIZATION.—There are authorized to be
8 appropriated to the Department of Commerce to carry out
9 the purposes of this Act—

10 “(1) \$42,813,000 for the fiscal year 1993;

1 “(2) such sums as may be necessary for the fis-
2 cal year 1994; and

3 “(3) such additional amounts, for each such fis-
4 cal year, as may be necessary for increases in salary,
5 pay, retirement, other employee benefits authorized
6 by law, and other nondiscretionary costs.”.

7 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE ACT.**

8 Section 20 of the Export Administration Act of 1979
9 (50 U.S.C. App. 2419) is amended by striking “September
10 30, 1990” and inserting “June 30, 1994”.
