A BILL

To provide interim current census data on below poverty, urban, rural, and farm populations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Census Data Fair
5 Share Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. INTERIM CURRENT DATA, POPULATION.**

7 Section 181 of title 13, United States Code, is
8 amended by redesignating subsection (b) as subsection (c)

1 and inserting after subsection (a) the following new sub-
2 section:

3 “(b) During the intervals between each census of pop-
4 ulation required under section 141 of this title, the Sec-
5 retary, to the extent feasible, shall annually produce and
6 publish for each State, urban area, and rural area, current
7 data or estimates on below poverty, urban, rural, and farm
8 populations. Such data or estimates shall be produced and
9 published for each State, urban area, and rural area for
10 which data is compiled in the most recent census of popu-
11 lation taken under section 141 of this title. Such data or
12 estimates may be produced by means of sampling or other
13 methods, which the Secretary determines will produce cur-
14 rent, comprehensive, and reliable data or estimates.”.
