To name the United States courthouse in Benton, Illinois, the “James L. Foreman Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. JAMES L. FOREMAN COURTHOUSE.**

2 (a) NAME.—The United States courthouse located at
3 301 West Main Street in Benton, Illinois, is named the
4 “James L. Foreman Courthouse”.

5 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law, regula-
6 tion, document, record, map, or other paper of the United
7 States to the courthouse referred to in subsection (a) is
8 deemed to be a reference to the “James L. Foreman
9 Courthouse”.

10 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

11 *The United States courthouse located at 301 West*
12 *Main Street in Benton, Illinois, shall be known and des-*
13 *ignated as the “James L. Foreman United States Court-*
14 *house”.*

15 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

16 *Any reference in any law, map, regulation, document,*
17 *paper, or other record of the United States to the courthouse*
18 *referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference*
19 *to the “James L. Foreman United States Courthouse”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to designate
the United States courthouse in Benton, Illinois, as the
‘James L. Foreman United States Courthouse’.”.
