A BILL

To extend the existing suspension of duty on metal oxide varistors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY**

5 Heading 9902.85.33 (relating to metal oxide
6 varistors) of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the Unit-
7 ed States is amended by striking “12/31/92” and inserting
8 “12/31/97”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF DUTY SUSPENSION.**

2 The amendment made by section 1 applies only to
3 metal oxide varistors weighing less than 2.5 kilograms,
4 (provided for in subheading 8533.40.00.)

5 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 The amendment made by section 1 applies to goods
7 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,
8 after December 31, 1992.
