A BILL

To eliminate the outdated price support and production adjustment program for honey, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Honey Price Support
5 Elimination Act of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF HONEY PRICE SUPPORT.**

2 Sections 207 and 405A of the Agricultural Act of
3 1949 (7 U.S.C. 1446h and 1425a, respectively) are re-
4 pealed.

5 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

6 (a) PAYMENT LIMITATIONS.—Section 1001(2) of the
7 Food Security Act of 1985 (7 U.S.C. 1308(2)) is amend-
8 ed—

9 (1) in subparagraph (B)(iii), by striking “(other
10 than honey)”; and

11 (2) by striking subparagraph (C).

12 (b) DESIGNATED NONBASIC AGRICULTURAL COM-
13 MODITIES.—Section 201(a) of the Agricultural Act of
14 1949 (7 U.S.C. 1446(a)) is amended by striking “honey,”.

15 (c) OTHER NONBASIC AGRICULTURAL COMMOD-
16 ITIES.—Section 301 of the Agricultural Act of 1949 (7
17 U.S.C. 1447) is amended by inserting after “nonbasic ag-
18 ricultural commodity” the following: “(other than
19 honey)”.

20 (d) DEFINITIONS.—Section 408(k) of the Agricul-
21 tural Act of 1949 (7 U.S.C. 1428(k)) is amended by strik-
22 ing “honey,” each place it appears.

23 (e) POWERS OF COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORA-
24 TION.—Section 5(a) of the Commodity Credit Corporation
25 Charter Act (15 U.S.C. 714c(a)) is amended by inserting

1 after “agricultural commodities” the following: “(other
2 than honey)”.

3 **SEC. 4. TRANSITION PROVISIONS.**

4 The amendments made by this Act shall not affect
5 the liability of any person under any provision of law as
6 in effect before the application of the amendments in ac-
7 cordance with section 5.

8 **SEC. 5. APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**

9 The amendments made by this Act shall apply begin-
10 ning with the crop year that begins after the date of enact-
11 ment of this Act.
