Mrs. JOHNSON of Connecticut introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to allow Federal employees to seek election to local office, and otherwise take an active part in political management or in political campaigns relating to an election to such an office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) paragraph (1) of section 7326 of title 5, United
4 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

5 “(1) an election and the preceding campaign
6 if—

7 “(A) none of the candidates is to be nomi-
8 nated or elected at that election as representing

1 a party any of whose candidates for presidential
2 elector received votes in the last preceding elec-
3 tion at which presidential electors were selected;
4 or

5 “(B) it involves an election for a municipal
6 or other local office (as defined under regula-
7 tions which the Office of Personnel Manage-
8 ment shall prescribe); or”.

9 (b)(1) The heading for section 7326 of title 5, United
10 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

11 **“§ 7326. Nonpartisan and certain other political activ-
12 ity permitted”.**

13 (2) The table of sections for chapter 73 of title 5,
14 United States Code, is amended by striking the item relat-
15 ing to section 7326 and inserting the following:

“7326. Nonpartisan and certain other political activity permitted.”.
