## A BILL

To withdraw certain lands located in the Coronado National Forest from the mining and mineral leasing laws of the United States, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Cave Creek Canyon  
5        Protection Act of 1993”.

6        **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF LANDS WITHIN CAVE CREEK CAN-**  
7        **YON DRAINAGE.**

8        (a) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to valid existing rights,  
9        after the date of enactment of this Act lands within the

1 Cave Creek Canyon Drainage are withdrawn from location  
2 under the general mining laws, the operation of the min-  
3 eral and geothermal leasing laws and the mineral material  
4 disposal laws.

5 (b) DEFINITION.—For the purposes of this Act, the  
6 term “Cave Creek Canyon Drainage” means lands and in-  
7 terest in lands owned by the United States within the area  
8 depicted on the map of record entitled “Cave Creek Min-  
9 eral Withdrawal”, dated November 1, 1991. The map  
10 shall be on file and available for public inspection in the  
11 offices of the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.
