## A BILL

To exclude shipboard supervisory personnel from selection as employer representatives, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LABOR ORGANIZATION REPRESENTATION EX-**

4 **CLUSION.**

5 Section 8(b)(1)(B) of the National Labor Relations  
6 Act (29 U.S.C. 158(b)(1)(B)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking the semicolon after “adjustment  
8 of grievances”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following: “: *Pro-*  
10 *vided, That such employer representatives shall not*

1 include shipboard supervisory personnel licensed by  
2 the United States Coast Guard and represented by  
3 a labor organization: *Provided further*, That any  
4 picketing or other economic activity undertaken by a  
5 labor organization on behalf of such licensed ship-  
6 board supervisory personnel shall not be considered  
7 a prohibited restraint or coercion.”.
