A BILL

To ensure employee rights concerning the payment of union dues.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUATION OF POLICY REGARDING NOTI-**
4 **FICATION OF EMPLOYEE RIGHTS CONCERN-**
5 **ING PAYMENT OF UNION DUES.**

6 Executive Order 12800 of April 13, 1992, and all De-
7 partment of Labor directives and regulations regarding
8 notification of employee rights concerning the payment of
9 union dues, as in effect on January 1, 1993, shall remain
10 in effect unless changed by law.
