3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION OF**  
4 **DUTY ON CERTAIN MONOCHROME GLASS EN-**  
5 **VELOPES.**

6 Heading 9902.70.11 of the Harmonized Tariff  
7 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking “12/  
8 31/92” and inserting “12/31/98”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2       The amendment made by section 1 takes effect on  
3 January 1, 1993.
