RESOLUTION

Limiting the mileage allowance rates for Members, officers, and employees of the House of Representatives to the rates generally applicable to Government employees.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON MILEAGE ALLOWANCE RATES**

3 **FOR MEMBERS, OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES**

4 **OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

5 Notwithstanding any law or any rule or other author-
6 ity, the mileage allowance rates for Members, officers, and
7 employees of the House of Representatives may not exceed
8 the mileage allowance rates prescribed by the Adminis-

1 trator of General Services under section 5707 of title 5,
2 United States Code.

3 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS.**

4 The Committee on House Administration of the
5 House of Representatives shall have authority to prescribe
6 regulations to carry out this resolution.

7 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 The limitation under section 1 shall apply with re-
9 spect to travel performed after the date on which this reso-
10 lution is agreed to.
