## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 920) to extend the emergency unemployment compensation program, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 920) to extend the emergency unemployment compensa-  
4 tion program, and for other purposes. The amendment  
5 recommended by the Committee on Ways and Means  
6 printed in the bill and the amendment printed in the re-  
7 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolu-

1 tion shall be considered as adopted. All points of order  
2 against the bill, as amended, and against its consideration  
3 are waived. Debate on the bill shall not exceed two hours  
4 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
5 ing minority member of the Committee on Ways and  
6 Means. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
7 dered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without  
8 intervening motion except one motion to recommit.
