Mr. HAMILTON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

## RESOLUTION

Providing amounts from the contingent fund of the House for one-half of the expenses of investigations and studies by the Joint Committee on the Organization of the Congress in the first session of the One Hundred Third Congress.

1       *Resolved*, That (a) for one-half of the expenses of in-  
2 vestigations and studies by the Joint Committee on the  
3 Organization of the Congress (hereinafter in this resolu-  
4 tion referred to as the “Committee”), including expenses  
5 for procurement of consultant services under section  
6 202(i) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946,

1 there shall be paid out of the contingent fund of the House  
2 not more than \$495,000.

3 (b) Not more than \$50,000 of the amount specified  
4 in subsection (a) may be used for consultant services re-  
5 ferred to in such subsection.

6 SEC. 2. Payments under this resolution shall be made  
7 on vouchers signed by the House of Representatives co-  
8 chairman of the Committee and approved by the Commit-  
9 tee on House Administration.

10 SEC. 3. Amounts shall be available under this resolu-  
11 tion for investigations and studies carried out during the  
12 period beginning at noon on January 3, 1993, and ending  
13 on December 31, 1993.

14 SEC. 4. Amounts made available under this resolution  
15 shall be expended in accordance with regulations pre-  
16 scribed by the Committee on House Administration.
