RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 920) to extend the emergency unemployment compensation program, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House, any rule of
3 the House to the contrary notwithstanding, a motion to
4 take from the Speaker's table the bill (H.R. 920) to extend
5 the emergency unemployment compensation program, and
6 for other purposes, with the Senate amendment thereto,
7 and to concur in the Senate amendment. The Senate

1 amendment shall be considered as read. The motion shall
2 be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled
3 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
4 Committee on Ways and Means or their respective des-
5 ignees. The previous question shall be considered as or-
6 dered on the motion to final adoption without intervening
7 motion. The motion shall be divided for a separate vote
8 on concurring in section 7 of the Senate amendment, any
9 rule of the House to the contrary notwithstanding.
