# RESOLUTION

To amend rule XLVIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives to provide for a phased reduction in the size of the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence.

1       *Resolved*, That rule XLVIII of the Rules of the House  
2 of Representatives is amended in clause 1(a) by striking  
3 out “The select committee shall be composed of not more  
4 than nineteen Members with representation to” and in lieu  
5 thereof inserting “Beginning on January 1, 1994, the se-  
6 lect committee shall be composed of not more than eight-  
7 een Members, of not more than eleven may be from the  
8 same party. Beginning on January 1, 1995, the select  
9 committee shall be composed of not more than sixteen

1 Members, of which not more than ten may be from the  
2 same party. Beginning with the One Hundred Sixth Con-  
3 gress and each Congress thereafter, the select committee  
4 shall be composed of not more than thirteen Members, of  
5 which not more than seven may be from the same party.  
6 The select committee shall”.
