Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1335) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1335) making emergency supple-
6 mental appropriations for the fiscal year ending Septem-
7 ber 30, 1993, and for other purposes. The first reading

1 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against
2 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause
3 2(l)(6) of rule XI or clause 7 of rule XXI are waived. Gen-
4 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
5 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
6 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
7 Appropriations. After general debate the Committee of the
8 Whole shall rise without motion. No further consideration
9 of the bill shall be in order except pursuant to a subse-
10 quent order of the House.
