## RESOLUTION

Providing for the further consideration of the bill (H.R. 1335) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider further in the House the  
3 bill (H.R. 1335) making emergency supplemental appro-  
4 priations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993,  
5 and for other purposes. All points of order against the bill  
6 are waived. It shall be in order to consider one amend-

1 ment, if offered by the chairman of the Committee on Ap-  
2 propriations. The amendment shall be considered as read,  
3 shall be debatable for ten minutes equally divided and con-  
4 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
5 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-  
6 mand for division of the question. All points of order  
7 against the amendment are waived. The previous question  
8 shall be considered as ordered on the amendment and on  
9 the bill to final passage without intervening motion except  
10 one motion to recommit, if offered by Representative  
11 Michel of Illinois or his designee. A motion to recommit  
12 with instructions shall be debatable for one hour equally  
13 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent.
