RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that any change in the current policy regarding homosexuals in the Armed Forces should be made by law, rather than by Executive order.

2 resentatives that any change in the current policy regard-
3 ing homosexuals in the Armed Forces (stating that homo-
4 sexuality is incompatible with military service and requir-
5 ing the separation from the Armed Forces of military per-
6 sonnel who are homosexual) should be made by law, rather
7 than by Executive order.
