Mr. WHEAT, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution;  
which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the joint resolution (S.J.  
Res. 45) authorizing the use of United States Armed  
Forces in Somalia.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the joint resolution (S.J. Res. 45) authorizing the  
6 use of United States Armed Forces in Somalia. The first  
7 reading of the joint resolution shall be dispensed with.

1 General debate shall be confined to the joint resolution  
2 and the amendments made in order by this resolution and  
3 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled  
4 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the  
5 Committee on Foreign Affairs. After general debate the  
6 joint resolution shall be considered for amendment under  
7 the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as  
8 an original text for the purpose of amendment under the  
9 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
10 stitute recommended by the Committee on Foreign Affairs  
11 now printed in the joint resolution. The committee amend-  
12 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as  
13 read. Points of order against the committee amendment  
14 in the nature of a substitute for failure to comply with  
15 clause 7 of rule XVI are waived. No amendment to the  
16 committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall  
17 be in order except those printed in the report of the Com-  
18 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each  
19 amendment may be offered only in the order printed, may  
20 be offered only by the named proponent or a designee,  
21 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time  
22 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by  
23 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to  
24 amendment (except that pro forma amendments for the  
25 purpose of debate may be offered by the chairman or rank-

1 ing minority member of the Committee on Foreign Af-  
2 fairs), and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
3 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the  
4 Whole. At the conclusion of consideration of the joint reso-  
5 lution for amendment the Committee shall rise and report  
6 the joint resolution to the House with such amendments  
7 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a  
8 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
9 in the Committee of the Whole to the joint resolution or  
10 to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.  
11 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
12 the joint resolution and amendments thereto to final pas-  
13 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-  
14 commit with or without instructions.
