RESOLUTION

Providing for the termination of official funding of certain legislative service organizations.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF OFFICIAL FUNDING OF CER-**

3 **TAIN LEGISLATIVE SERVICE ORGANIZA-**

4 **TIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection

6 (b), effective July 1, 1993, no legislative service organiza-

7 tion may—

8 (1) receive amounts from the clerk hire allow-

9 ance or the official expenses allowance; or

1 (2) use office space or any other facility or serv-
2 ice that is paid for from official funds.

3 (b) SPECIAL RULE.—Subsection (a) shall not apply
4 with respect to one legislative service organization for each
5 political party represented in the House, if such legislative
6 service organization is devoted solely to legislative research
7 and legislative support for the Members of the House who
8 are affiliated with such political party.

9 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

10 As used in section 1, the term “legislative service or-
11 ganization” has the meaning given that term in paragraph
12 (1) of the regulation of the Committee on House Adminis-
13 tration on legislative service organizations, dated October
14 21, 1981.
