Mr. FROST, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2244) making supplemental appropriations, transfers, and rescissions for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes, and waiving points of order against the bill (H.R. 2118) making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes, and against its consideration.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of

1 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
2 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
3 ation of the bill (H.R. 2244) making supplemental appro-
4 priations, transfers, and rescissions for the fiscal year end-
5 ing September 30, 1993, and for other purposes. The first
6 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
7 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
8 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
9 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
11 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
12 for amendment under the five-minute rule. The amend-
13 ments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules
14 accompanying this resolution shall be considered as adopt-
15 ed in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The
16 bill as so amended shall be considered as the original bill
17 for the purpose of further amendment under the five-
18 minute rule. All points of order against the bill, as so
19 amended, are waived. At the conclusion of consideration
20 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and
21 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may
22 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
23 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
24 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
25 tion to recommit.

1 SEC. 2. All points of order against the bill (H.R.
2 2118) making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal
3 year ending September 30, 1993, and for other purposes,
4 and against its consideration are waived. The following
5 amendment to the bill shall be considered as adopted in
6 the House and in the Committee of the Whole: page 12,
7 strike line 20 and all that follows through page 13, line
8 19.
