Mr. DERRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2264) to provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 7 of the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1994.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2264) to provide for reconciliation
6 pursuant to section 7 of the concurrent resolution on the
7 budget for fiscal year 1994. The first reading of the bill

1 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
2 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
3 fined to the bill and the amendments made in order by
4 this resolution and shall not exceed two hours equally di-
5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
6 ity member of the Committee on the Budget. After general
7 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
8 the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read. The
9 modifications to the bill printed in part 1 of the report
10 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution
11 shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the
12 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against the
13 bill, as modified, are waived. No amendment to the bill,
14 as modified, shall be in order except the amendment in
15 the nature of a substitute printed in part 2 of the report.
16 The amendment in the nature of a substitute may be of-
17 fered only by Representative Kasich of Ohio or his des-
18 ignee, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
19 one hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent
20 and an opponent, and shall not be subject to amendment.
21 All points of order against the amendment in the nature
22 of a substitute are waived. At the conclusion of consider-
23 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
24 and report the bill, as modified, to the House with such
25 amendment as may have been adopted. The previous ques-

1 tion shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-
2 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
3 except one motion to recommit, which may not include
4 instructions.
